

# Mark Bell Joins KYSA As Senior Staff Coach!

Mark is a Canadian Soccer National B Licence coach. He also holds a National Soccer Coaches Association of America Advanced National Coaching Diploma. He most recently served as an assistant coach of the Douglas College Women's Soccer Team in New Westminster. The Douglas College Royals reached the finals of the 2016 CCAA National Championships held in Montreal, November 9-12,

where they finished with the Bronze Medal—the first time the College Women's Team has returned with some silverware.

In addition to his role with the College team, Mark was a staff coach for the Westview High School Soccer Academy in Maple Ridge as well as a paid coach with the West Coast Auto Group FC in Maple Ridge/Pitt Meadows. He also ran his own "Simple Soccer" Player Academy in the summer months.
