

2017 KYSA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

APPLICATION RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Number of available scholarships:

A number of scholarships, each in the amount of \$500, are awarded by the Kamloops Youth Soccer Association and its sponsors to outstanding student-athletes on an annual basis. Preference is given to those candidates who have been active participants (members) in the KYSA for a prolonged period.

The decisions rendered by the KYSA Scholarship Selection Panel are final.

2. Scholarships shall be awarded to:

- Students proceeding from Grade 12 to a University or other post-secondary institution acceptable to the KYSA Scholarship Selection Panel.
- Students already attending a post-secondary institute, but are under 18 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.

3. Applicants must:

- Complete the application in full and provide all required information, documents and letters in order for their application to be considered.
- Have demonstrated a proficiency in soccer as indicated by their worthwhile contributions in playing, coaching, refereeing or through a role in the administration of the game.
- Have exhibited good citizenship, character, leadership and sportsmanship while he or she has been a participant in the sport.
- Have been registered with the KYSA for three or more seasons to be eligible for a KYSA scholarship (does not have to be three consecutive years).

4. The following documents must accompany this application:

- A letter from the Principal or Post-Secondary Administrator certifying the candidate's age, character, ability and listing the candidate's participation in any school activities.
- A transcript of the student's marks or a photocopy of the permanent record card. If neither is available, a
 typed copy of the permanent record verified by the Principal or Post-Secondary Administrator will be accepted.
- A letter from the applicant's coach or a team official indicating the candidate's character, leadership, sports-manship and participation in community activities as well as information regarding the candidate's soccer ability or contribution to refereeing, coaching or in an administrative capacity.

5. Award Claims:

- Scholarship recipients will be required to provide proof of registration at an acceptable post-secondary institute before payment of the award will be forthcoming.
- Scholarship winners will have a period of two years to claim their award.
