MIKE BARTRAM MEMORIAL YOUTH SOCCER TOURNAMENT
Saturday/Sunday/Monday May 6/7/8, 2017



Here is some general information for you and your team about the upcoming Mike Bartram Memorial Youth Soccer Tournament!

All U13 to U18 teams in the "House" program are eligible to participate in this event. Please keep in mind this is intended to be a "fun" event where competition isn't a priority, as it is in the end of season playoffs!

Your team will be playing at least three games over the weekend, possibly more. The "format" for the tournament depends on the number of teams in your division. For this event, we try and use a round-robin format where possible (Mike subscribed to this format when he was involved.)

We ask that a team representative pick-up their team packages from the KYSA office on McArthur Island prior to the tournament if possible. The KYSA office will be open from 9:00am to 4:00pm, Thursday, May 4 and from 9:00am to 6:30pm on Friday, May 5, and during the tournament. This year, the KYSA will be supplying **boot bags** to each player as a souvenir. Official Headquarters for the tournament will be at KYSA office. The office will be staffed throughout the tournament to assist you if needed.

General rules and regs for the tournament are:

DURATION OF GAMES:

Game times will consist of 2 equal halves of 30 minutes in ALL age groups. There will be NO overtime played in any game, **including finals!**

SCORING:

Each team will receive 6 points for a win, three points for a tie. A "no-show" will mean automatic forfeiture of points for that game--the opponents will be awarded a maximum of seven points for a default win. No points are awarded for shut-outs. No points will be awarded if neither team appears for a game.

The tie-breaking method in the event teams are tied on points in round-robin loops after all games are complete or for moving forward to the next round is:

1. Head-to-head record
2. Goals against
3. Goal differential (the higher number wins)
4. Coin toss

SCORE REPORTING:

This year we are employing Field Marshals to collect and report the score at each field. Match results will be posted on a scoreboard outside/adjacent to the KYSA office. Scores and standings will also be available on the KYSA web site.

AWARDS:

The KYSA will be awarding medals to the top two teams in each age group. In divisions where the format is round-robin, the first- and second-place teams after all games are complete will receive medals. In divisions where the format calls for a final game, both the champions and runner-up will receive medals. In the event of a tie in the standings of round-robin groups, both teams will receive champions medals regardless of goal difference, etc. In the event of a tie in one-game "finals", both teams will receive championship medals.

Teams who qualify for awards should make their way to the KYSA office immediately following their last game for the medal presentations.

DRAW PRIZES:

Each year, as part of the Bartram tournament, draws are conducted and a host of prizes are awarded to players and team officials. Entry ballots will be included in the team packages. Team coaches or managers are asked to distribute them as soon as possible.

There will be a draw for team officials AND a draw for participating players.

Entry ballots must be deposited in the draw boxes in the KYSA office board room by 10:00am, Sunday, May 7th to be eligible.

KYSA directors and office staff contact local businesses to donate to the prize pool. If you are either employed at, or know of, a company that would be prepared to make a donation to our prize pool, please let us know. The more prizes the better!
