TRU Wins Bronze in USports Nationals!



Sunday, November 12 will go down in the history books as the first time a TRU Wolfpack soccer team earned a medal at the USports National Men's Soccer Championships. The boys captured a Bronze Medal after defeating UBC Thunderbirds 3-2 in a penalty-kick shootout at Hillside Stadium!

KYSA graduates in the squad, made history at the USports Men's National Club Championships by winning their first ever medal in their first ever appearance in the tournament.

The WolfPack upset York University in the quarter-final, 1-0, then lost a heartbreaking semi-final match to eventual champions Cape Breton, 4-2. The loss put TRU into the match for 3rd and 4th- | and the players on this significant achievement.
